

# Getting started with Kindle® eReaders

You can borrow Kindle Books (U.S. only) from your library, and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle eReader.

**NOTE:** If you have a Kindle Fire, you may be able to use the OverDrive app to borrow and download eBooks directly to your device. For more help, visit [help.overdrive.com](http://help.overdrive.com).

## STEP 1

Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone to open your library's website. Find it using

[overdrive.com/libraries](http://overdrive.com/libraries)



## STEP 2

On your library's OverDrive website, use the search filters to find and borrow an eBook that's available in the Kindle Book format.

## STEP 3

From your Checkouts page, select **Read now with Kindle**. You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

## STEP 4

On Amazon's website, follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle eReader. You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.



**NOTE:** Your Kindle eReader must have a Wi-Fi internet connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you will need to transfer the Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader via USB.

Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader, it works like any other Kindle Book.
